MANDATORY GRADUATION REHEARSAL - May 31st @ 8:30am

- The rehearsal is mandatory and where we get everyone lined up.
- Following rehearsal there will be a senior breakfast.
- Finally, Seniors will participate in their senior parade.
 - Seniors will parade through the outside halls from the cafeteria to the student parking lot where they will be dismissed.

MANDATORY GRADUATION REHEARSAL – June 1st @ 8:30am

Douglas Anderson – SENIORS CANNOT BE LATE

**Failure to attend, or being tardy to, mandatory rehearsal will result in the student not being able to participate in the commencement ceremony. **

- There will be a bus available at DA for seniors to ride to/from rehearsal.
 - o Seniors are responsible for ensuring they arrive to rehearsal on time.
 - You do not need your caps and gowns for rehearsal, but you should bring the shoes you plan to wear during the commencement ceremony, especially if they are high heels.
- GRADUATION TICKETS
 - Each senior will be given (6) four tickets when they receive their cap/gown
 - Seniors can earn an additional (2) tickets for maximum of 8:
 - (1) Getting scholarship information uploaded
 - (2) Guardian and senior signing the graduation pledge

GRADUATION – Thursday, June 1st, 7:00pm – Moran Theatre

Seniors will enter the Terry Lobby through the Hogan Street entrance

- Seniors must arrive no later than 6:15pm (dressed and ready) and enter through the Terry Lobby, Hogan Street entrance
 - Dress code for graduation
 - Pants must be dark colored dress pants, NO JEANS
 - Shoes must be dress shoes, NO SLIPPERS, FLIP FLOPS or BACKLESS SHOES.
 - Dresses should not hang below the robe
 - Caps MAY NOT be decorated during the ceremony
- You will enter the Terry Lobby through the Hogan Street side-entrance (graduates ONLY).
- You should enter with only your cap, gown, tassel, medallion, and cords(s)
 - Please leave all other items (keys, phone, etc.) with someone else. You will not be allowed to have any items on your person during the ceremony.
- Immediately after the ceremony, return to the robing area to get your diploma from the same person you checked in with. You will keep your cap, gown, diploma cover, tassel, medallion, and cord(s)
 - Once you receive your diploma, you will exit onto Hogan Street to meet your families and friends at the corner of Water Street and Hogan Street.
- House doors will open at 6:00pm for seating of guests
 - ALL persons entering graduation must have a ticket (including infants)
 - There will be no will-call for tickets, seniors are responsible for ensuring guests get their tickets prior to the ceremony

Other important information

- The Times-Union Center will be checking bags. If possible, leave all bags behind. Guests should come early and be prepared to have all bags searched. This is the venue's policy.
- The graduation rehearsal is mandatory for any senior planning to participate in the commencement ceremony. Seniors must be on time for rehearsal to ensure participation.
- Graduates are held responsible for the behavior of their guests. Please tell your guests to refrain from applause or yelling when the graduates' names are called. Failure to do so will result in diplomas being pulled. We want to ensure that every graduate and their family can hear their name announced during the ceremony.
