  - Providing parents with monthly reports on their children’s progress. Specifically, the school will provide reports twice during each nine-weeks grading period (approximately every 4 ½ weeks);
  - Scheduling parent conferences with teachers by contacting the school office or during the teachers’ planning time. In addition, teacher will communicate with parents through the daily planners and Tuesday folders;
  - Volunteering and participating in their child’s classroom activities by contacting the teacher; observing classroom activities by contacting the teacher or school principal
