Diagnostic tests indicate what sub-skill levels need improvement for individual learners and targets instruction to help assure the learner is on track to meet end-of-year goals.	Students complete at least two lessons per week at a score of 75% or higher. Students spend 45 minutes working in i_Ready. Green path is based on student's diagnostic results and can be accessed anytime. Blue path contains

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			teacher assignments and should be completed first.
