

## FHP Summer 2022 Math

Math is a subject that needs to be practiced regularly, especially if you hope to retain knowledge and continue to progress in your math skills. Math is necessary in everyday life and working through math problems builds problem solving skills that can last a lifetime. Keep your math brain active over the summer, so you don't struggle this Fall!

This summer, you should complete at least 75% of one of the following assignments in Delta Math.

Students that are:	Assignment Name
Moving into Algebra 1A	Level Alpha
Moving into Algebra 1; or didn't have a consistent math teacher for Algebra 1 in the 2021-2022 school year.	Level Beta
Moving into Algebra 2 or Geometry; or didn't have a consistent math teacher for Algebra 2 in the 2021-2022 school year; or have completed Algebra 2 and Geometry, but struggled in one or both courses.	Level Gamma
Happily moving into Pre-Calc or Calculus	Level Delta

Additionally, this will be your **first graded assignment for your Fall 2022 math class**. Try your best, watch help videos, and if you are still struggling, skip that topic and move onto the next one. Aim to practice for 30 minutes a week, most weeks over the summer. While this is an online assignment, you should still use paper, pencil, and calculators to find your answers.

To receive full credit, you need to complete at least 75% from one of the above levels. However, math teachers will also take into consideration time spent on the assignment. For example, if a student can only answer 50% of the problems in their given level, but has spent 30 minutes a week working (attempting problems/watching help videos) in DeltaMath, they likely will receive full credit for the assignment. (Note: Only teachers will be able to see time spent in DeltaMath, this information is not available from the student view).

### To access DeltaMath and assignments

- If you have used DeltaMath.com in the past, and remember your login info:
  - Sign-in using your past login information. You may see your old class(es).
  - Click on the "Tools" link in the top right corner
  - Then click "Login/School Information"
  - Enter the Code: 6TC8-Y6CA
  
- If you have never used DeltaMath or don't remember your login information, go to either:
  - <https://www.deltamath.com/students?code=6TC8-Y6CA> and follow the instructions to create a new account.
  - Or go to DeltaMath.com
    - Click "For Students" → "Register"
    - Enter the Code: 6TC8-Y6CA
    - Complete the registration process.
