“Duval Homeroom” – Distance Learning Plan

- I. The schedule
 - a. The schedule allows for each class to meet virtually, through the “Teams” platform for 40 minutes daily and follows the existing 8-period schedule already in place for the 2019-2020 school year. This allows flexibility for the teacher to plan a virtual focus lesson of lecture and question/answer, post videos for viewing and note taking, etc. Teachers should plan to use this time for direct instruction and/or assessment (understanding limitations on time and accommodations).
 - b. Built into the schedule is a 45 minute “Teacher Conference Time.” During this time the teachers are expected to be online and available for student questions and clarification, or to meet with small groups for differentiated instruction (teachers can create smaller Teams groups for this if needed). This is also a time when accommodations can be administered for assessments.
 - c. As the schedule includes all of the periods from Stanton’s traditional A/B block schedule, teachers will have two 40-minute planning periods a day as well as a school-wide 30-minute duty free lunch time.
 - d. Teachers will have a 5 minute “Check-in” time in the morning, 8:00am-8:05am, and the afternoon, 3:15pm-3:20pm during which, each teacher will notify Ms. Majova of their presence through the “Majova Tribe” Team.
- II. Attendance
 - a. Teachers will mark all students “Present” in Focus and follow-up the attendance, marking students absent using direct instruction time, assignment submission, and log-in to blended learning platforms as verification.
- III. Grading and Homework
 - a. As assignments and assessments are given to students, submitted and graded, teachers should update Focus as per normal protocol.
 - b. Teachers should keep in mind that classes are, during this distance learning time, meeting every day. As such, if every teacher assigns 30 minutes of homework, this is 4 hours of daily homework, beyond the 4 ½ hours of class time for our students. With that in mind, please be thoughtful with the assignment of homework and devise a system that will allow the demonstration of standards mastery to be measured during this unprecedented circumstance. Please use discernment when determining necessary practice versus “busy work.”
- IV. AP & IB
 - a. The school is being notified of plans for AP & IB testing by College Board and the International Baccalaureate. Mr. Malone and Mr. Nasrallah will send updates and protocols and create a plan for May testing when we have a clearer picture of how those two organizations are proceeding.
