AP/Honors Course Progression Important Information:

- This AP/Honors Course Progression should be used in conjunction with the AP/Honors Student Planning Sheet
- All requested Electives should be carefully examined in the Course Catalog for Pre & Co-requisite requirements
- AP/Honors 11th graders are required to take the Personal, Social, & Family Relations (PSFR) which is a 1 semester course and have the opportunity to choose the corresponding 1 semester elective between the ACT/SAT Test Prep course and the Strategies for Success Dual Enrollment Course
- AP/Honors designated students are required to take a minimum of 9 AP courses during their high school career. The required courses at Stanton are: AP World History, AP European History, AP US History, AP Macro Economics, AP US Government, AP English Language, AP English Literature, an AP Mathematics course, and an AP Science course
- This course progression is specific to Stanton AP/Honors students. It should be read from left to right with careful attention paid to pre-requisite courses as well as options available in the Mathematics, Science, and World Language areas.

Promotion Requirements

- To Grade 10: 5 credits including 1 English or 1 math
- To Grade 11: 12 credits including 2 English and any combination of 2 math and/or science
- To Grade 12: 18 credits including 3 English and any combination of 4 credits in math and/or science and a minimum grade point average (GPA) of a 1.5 on a 4.0 scale

Magnet Promotion Requirement: Students must maintain a 2.0 unweighted GPA and pass all courses.
