**Who:** 10 teachers per school with 15 students each (150 per school)

Limited to any student who attends a school listed above including magnet or special assignment

**What:** Supplemental instruction to fill learning gaps created during COVID-19 pandemic

**When:** Every Saturday from Aug. 15<sup>th</sup> through Oct 31<sup>st</sup> and 2 weekdays virtually (3:30 – 4:30 pm)

8:30 am – 2:00 pm (student hours)

8:00 am – 2:30 pm (teacher hours)

**Where:** 45 elementary schools, listed above

## Instruction Requirements:

- ✓ 5 hours of face-to-face instruction every Saturday
- ✓ 2 hours of virtual check-ins during the week
- ✓ Includes reading, writing, and math instruction

## Registration:

- **Student registration:** Online registration only. The first 150 students at each school to register will be accepted (with principal discretion). It will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Students must attend at their school of attendance.
- **Teacher application:** Online registration only. Teachers will select 3 schools and be placed at their first choice where there is an available position. *Teacher hourly rate applies.*  
**Teachers from across the district can apply.** They do not have to teach at one of the above schools.
- Principals will send out a robo-call to all applicable students once registration is ready.

## Details:

- Breakfast and lunch are provided.
  - Breakfast will be grab-n-go at 8:30 am.
  - Lunch will be 30 minutes in the cafeteria at 11:30 am.
- Bus transportation is provided following regular guidelines.
- One custodian at each school from 12:00 pm- 3:00 pm.
- CDC guidelines will be followed during this program.
