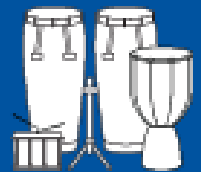

- Post weekly schedule of lessons

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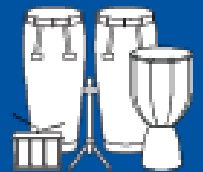
Student Expectations

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Accessing Class in Teams

- Go to oneview.duvalschools.org
- Sign in using DCPS credentials (s+student ID and password)
- Click on Sharepoint in the top left corner
- Click on Teams icon.
- Select class.

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
