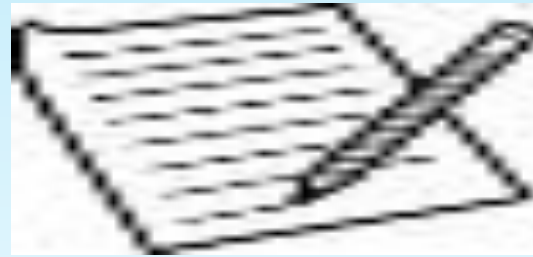


Communication

Absences, Tardiness and Early Pick-ups

- A student is considered tardy if they arrive after 8:30. Parents please come into the school with your child to check them in
- For the safety of the students, they can not be dismissed after 2:15 daily or 12:15 on Early Release Days
- When your child is absent from school, please send them in with a note.

Illness and Masks

- If a student is ill please keep them home and allow them to get better. Starting next week much of the reading instruction will be recorded and placed in the TEAMS platform in my reading section. This way students will not lose any of the valuable instruction they need to be successful this year.
- If a student is ill and displaying signs of coronavirus please have them see a doctor. Any student displaying signs associated with this illness will be sent home and not allowed to return to school without a doctor's note.
- For the safety of the students, please be sure to send kids to school with a mask, and any personal sanitation products that you can send with them. Please also remind students wearing cloth masks to **WASH** their masks each night to keep them healthy and free of germs.
- When your child is absent from school, please send them in with a note upon returning.
- Please send in sanitation supplies periodically to help us keep our classroom safe and clean.

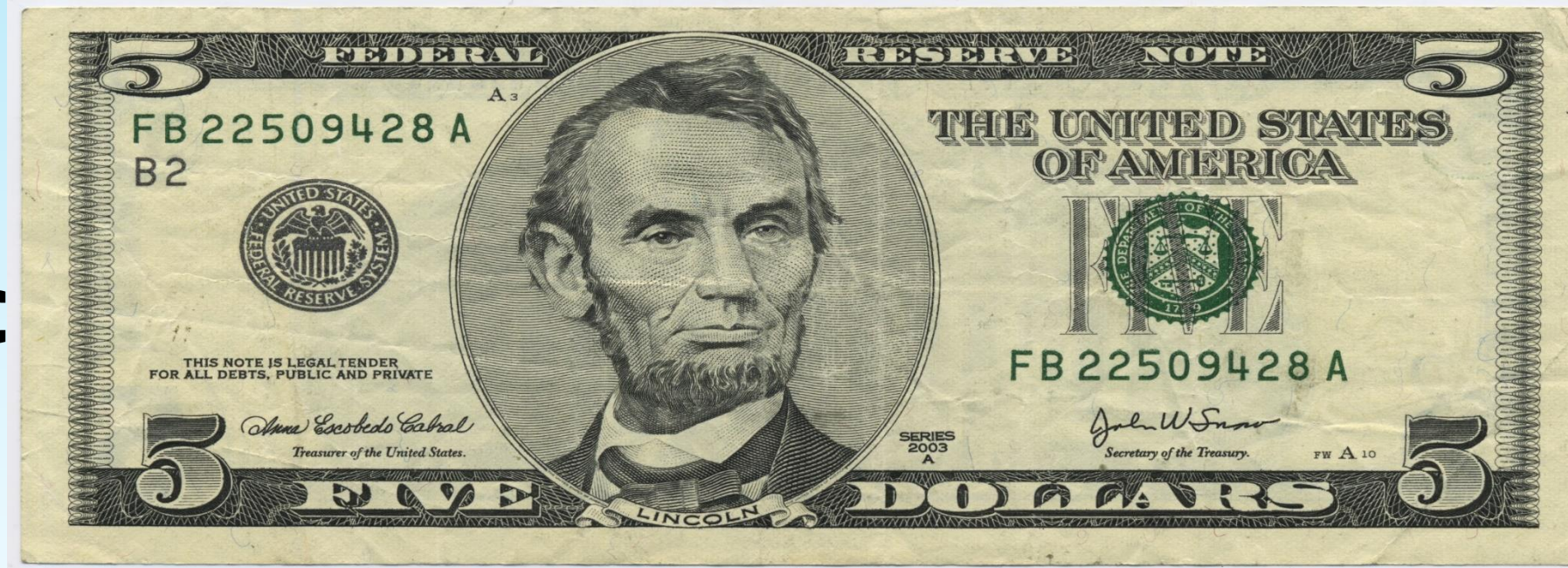


Visitors and Volunteers

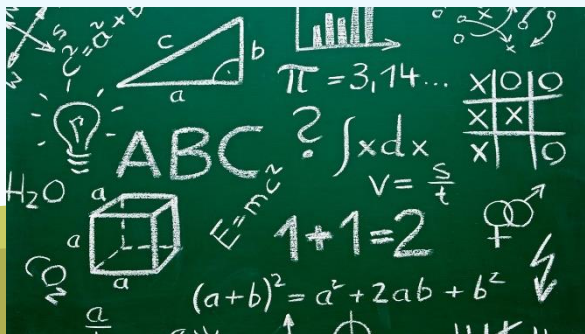
- Volunteers need to complete an application with the District at www.duvalschools.org (Volunteer)
- We have a new Volunteer/Visitor's Badge system. All visitors will need their Driver's License or a Florida ID to be issued a visitor's pass.
- Parents can schedule a conference with a teacher by messaging them on DOJO or leaving a message on their phone extension. Conferences can be scheduled before 8:00, after 3:10, during the teacher's planning time, or anytime previously agreed upon by both teacher and parent/guardian. Conferences can be held over the phone or via TEAMS (video conferencing).

Reading/Writing



- This year students learn strategies to help them successfully pass several learning domains;
 - In class instruction (reading/writing/Social Studies, Math, and Science)
 - FSA Reading /Writing and Math

 - Freckles (Reading and Math)
- Homework is sent home every week. The homework is a mirror of the standards covered in class so it is imperative that students are completing homework each day/week.



Math/Science Homework is given on a daily basis.

Reading/Writing Homework will be given on a weekly basis and not due until Friday.
