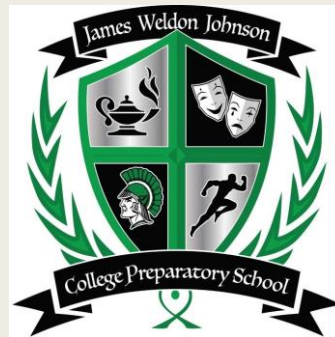

# Admission

- **Students apply through the lottery**
- **Preference is based on many variables : sibling preference, military preference, program continuity “feeder school”**
- **Program Continuity: R.V. Daniels, Jacksonville Beach Elementary, R.L. Brown, Central Riverside, Thomas Jefferson, San Mateo, and Holiday Hill**

# Application Process

- All applications **MUST** be submitted by the parents/guardians through the One View (FOCUS) Parent Portal Account online.
- Magnet applications are due **Monday, February 28, 2022.**

# Gifted and Academically Talented

- Gifted- students have already been identified (tested) as gifted (core classes are only taught by gifted endorsed teachers)
- Advanced/Academically Talented - self-motivated/directed, responsible, above grade level math FSA scores, academically driven.

# Magnet Requirements

- The student must maintain an overall GPA of 2.0
- The student must pass all core classes in order to be promoted
- JWJ offers ONLY advanced courses in a unique advanced curriculum

# Our Design

- Our schedule is currently an A/B schedule with 4-90 minute blocks on alternating days.
- 6th grade students are assigned 3 elective courses in addition to PE/Health
- Homework load averages 20 minutes per class- typically 1-1.5 hours a night



# Our Design

- **Our campus is set up with most core classes being housed in grade level buildings**
- **Students travel independently to classes and lunch**
- **Students are scheduled based on District requirements and student performance**
