

A1A (3rd Street) Drainage Improvements 5th Street Bridge Detour

Below and a link is an update regarding Road Closures surrounding Fletcher High School.

The 5th Street bridge closure is set to begin 5/1/19 to facilitate the construction of the new 5th Street Bridge crossing over the FDOT drainage canal. The detour route for the road closure is shown in the attached flier. The road closure is anticipated to be in effect through the summer months and reopen in early fall. During the closure, northbound 5th St traffic will be detoured on Seagate Ave to 4th St to Oleander St, and southbound 5th St traffic will be detoured from Oleander St to 4th St to Seagate Ave. The FDOT Public Information Office has notified the Duval County Public Schools Transportation Department of this detour so that bus routes may be altered accordingly.

In addition, the FDOT Contractor is also planning to construct the new Seagate Ave bridge this summer to minimize impacts to the schools adjacent to the project. The Contractor anticipates closing Seagate Ave the first week of June after school has released for the summer. During the road closure, the Contractor will be required to provide a temporary pedestrian bridge at Seagate Ave while the new bridge is being constructed to reduce the length of the pedestrian detour. The Seagate Ave intersection with 5th Street will be required to be reopened by July 26th, and the bridge crossing reopened by August 11th. The detour route in place for the 5th Street Bridge will change once Seagate Ave is closed. Instead of utilizing Seagate Ave for detouring traffic, traffic will instead be detoured using 3rd St, 18th Ave N and 10th St N. Additional information on this detour route will be provided at a later date.
