


Accessing Your Student's Tests in Focus - District – National – State

1. Log in to the Focus Parent Portal and select *My Child* (icon under the school house), then *Child Info*.
2. In the left column, select *Testing – District Tests*, *Testing – National Tests* or *Testing – State Tests*.
3. You will see a list of your child's assessments. In the area, *Testing – State Tests*, depending on the scale score, an achievement level is assigned. A Level 3 is considered passing for most state assessments, except for Grade 3 FSA ELA, which requires a Level 2.




Testing – District Tests


