

## DHR PSAT 8/9 & PSAT NMSQT October 29th Details

### Arrival and Pick-up Locations:

**9th grade students** who have already confirmed to take the PSAT 8/9 should plan on arriving at 7:30 am on the senior parking lot side of campus in order to test in Portable F7. Students will enter campus via the side senior parking lot gate. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival to campus. A mask must be worn at all times on campus, including testing. Pick-up will be in the same location, see pick-up times below.

**10th & 11th grade students** who have already confirmed to take the PSAT NMSQT should plan on arriving at 7:30 am on the bus loop side of campus in order to test in the Media Center. Students will be entering the main building Media Center through the rear, exterior Media Center doors (courtyard entrance) from the bus loop side. Temperatures will be taken upon arrival to campus. A mask must be worn at all times on campus, including testing. Pick-up will be in the same location, see pick-up times below.
