Electronically Registering Incoming Students Prior to a Course Scheduling Conference

In order to enroll online at FHS (without a paper packet from the school):

- *go to duvalschools.org
- *click on "parent"
- *click on "How to enroll"
- *click on "Enroll in your attendance area school"
- *scroll to the bottom of the page and click on "To enroll a student to Duval County Public Schools, click here. "
- *follow the on-screen directives from there
- *SPECIAL NOTE: when you get to the end of the enrollment process, the last page will offer you a student ID# verification. Please be sure to either print that last screen or take a picture of it and email it to innism@duvalschools.org as completion of process please. It will make our electronic next steps much easier on our end if we can have a copy of this last page.

When you have emailed us the enrollment confirmation page and the latest grades, then please reach out via email to archonk1@duvalschools.org with available dates and times that we can meet in-person (following social distancing guidelines), via conference call, or virtually to discuss elective and core class choices.
