

French Honor Society is a national honor society for students who are currently taking the French language as a course. French students who are in their second or higher year of French have the choice to get inducted. Students in their first year can be part of the society by being associate members. The club meets year-round, on the first non-early release Wednesday of every month, unless otherwise notified. Dues are \$20 per year (2016-17).

We have multiple projects throughout the year, aiming to help the local and international community. We have yearly drives to help an orphanage in Haiti, and other wellness centers throughout Jacksonville. Our members do a great deal of volunteer work, in order to keep their membership: teaching French in elementary school through the Little Language Learners program, assisting local elementary schools with their science nights, as well as additional community activities.
