9<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> grade = 5 credits: 1 credit must be English or math

10<sup>th</sup> to 11<sup>th</sup> grade = 12 credits: 2 credit must be English and 2 credit must be math and/or science

11<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade = 18 credits: 3 credits must be English and 4 credits must be math and/or science.
