## Criteria for consideration for FCHS 2020 Homecoming Court

Please read the following information carefully. Be sure you and your parent(s) or guardian(s) understand these criteria and guidelines, as we will not make exceptions for any student for any reason.

### To be considered for the court, each candidate must:

- Have a least a 2.5 weighted GPA and be in current good academic standing
  - No F's in Q1 of the 2020 Academic School Year
- Have not had any discipline referrals this school year
  - No level 2 or above referrals in the previous Academic School Year
  - Any class 1 referrals at any time must be reviewed by your administrator
- Participate in the Homecoming week activities
- Attend the Homecoming Football Game (10/30/2020)
  - Must be available to practice before the game (time TBD)
- Obtain at least 25 signatures from your **grade level peers**, supporting your candidacy for the court **(waived for 2020)**
- Obtain 2 Teacher Recommendations
- Obtain your grade level Administrator's signature/email approval
- Submit your **completed** application to Mrs. Solon by 2pm on Thursday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>
