Thank you to every family that completed the Duval Homeroom Testing Survey last week. We appreciate your patience as we work diligently to maintain a safe and socially distanced plan to welcome your child to campus safely to test. As a reminder, PMA 3 is a practice FSA and cannot be taken as a make-up from home per DCPS guidelines.

**Arrival:** Each DHR testing day, students will arrive (9:05 a.m.-9:25 a.m.) to campus as a walker/biker/ 6th grade car rider using the Seagate parking lot entrance, as a 7th/8th grade car rider/walker/biker through the 18th street entrance, bus riders will enter through our bus loop. All students will have their temperature taken and must be wearing a mask to enter campus. If your student does not have a mask, a mask will be provided for them.

**Dismissal:** Once your student is finished testing, they will notify you via phone to confirm they are finished. The estimated end time is 11:30 a.m. Please send your student with a snack as lunch/cafeteria rotation is not included. All parents can pick up their student once testing is finished from our bus loop off Seagate Avenue. Please do not report to the main office for pick up.
