Parents and Guardians,

Prior to the start of the new school year, it is critical that your rising 7th grade student receive all required immunizations. Immunizations must be administered to students according to the State of Florida Immunization Requirement Guidelines, which are updated each year. These immunizations are critical to the overall health of our school communities. Below, you will find the schedule of immunizations associated with various grade levels. Immunizations must be recorded on the appropriate form. A sample **Florida Certificate of Immunization form (DH680)** is also available on the district website at <http://www.duvalschools.org/Page/14089>. Medical professionals administering immunizations have access to the correct forms and can provide them to families to turn in to schools. Students must meet all immunization requirements before being admitted to school.

If your child does not meet school health entry requirements, he/she will be excluded from school until the required immunizations and documentation have been submitted to the school. Immunization Requirements for entry into any State of Florida school:

Grades 7-12:

- 4 or 5 DTaP
- 3, 4 or 5 Polio
- 2 MMRs
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 1 Tdap
- 2 Varicella (chicken pox) for **grades 7-11**
- 1 Varicella (chicken pox) for **grade 12**

Please note: The specific immunization needs of your child should be discussed with your health care provider or you are welcome to visit one of the Florida Department of Health – Duval County clinics for assistance.
