

- **NEW THIS YEAR:** Parents are no longer able to walk their child(ren) to class. We have a plan in place for the first two weeks of school that allows for additional supervision as students learn the rituals and routines of morning arrival. We know this may be difficult for some, please know that we are here to ensure that ALL students have an excellent start to the school day.

- **Morning Arrival** – As students arrive on campus, they will have their temperature checked prior to entering the building. PLEASE NOTE: students will not be able to attend school if they have a temperature of 100.4 or higher. Car riders with temperatures in excess of 100.4 must be taken home. Walkers and bus riders will be held in isolation until a parent or guardian comes to pick them up.
 - Car riders will remain in their cars until a staff member arrives to check their temperatures.
 - Back-Gate Walkers will stop at a checkpoint to have their temperature checked before entering the building.
 - Bus riders will have their temperature checked as they exit the school bus.
 - Students will no longer be seated in the hall outside of classrooms until 8:25. When students arrive to school, all students who wish to eat breakfast should report directly to the cafeteria. After eating breakfast, students will report to the appropriate supervision area. Students in grades Pre-K through 2nd will be supervised in the cafeteria. Students in grades 3rd- 5th will be supervised in the multipurpose room. Teachers will pick up students at 8:25 am and transition to class. All Pre-K students will eat breakfast in the classroom at 8:30. Face coverings must be worn at all times during morning arrival, with the exception of breakfast.

- **Afternoon Dismissal** – Students must wear face coverings during dismissal.

- **Changes to Dismissal:** All transportation changes must be submitted in writing to your child's teacher or our front office assistant, Mrs. Thomas, at thomasv2@duvalschools.org.
 - Changes will not be accepted over the phone, there are no exceptions.
 - Every student must have a permanent mode of transportation established. If changes to dismissal are not submitted in writing, the student will be sent home according to his/her established mode of transportation.
 - Car Riders @ 2:45: Please use the car rider loop on the East side of the building. Please write your student's name in bold on the car rider tag.

- Naval Station Mayport Youth Center @ 2:45: A faculty member will escort students to the basketball court. Two staff members from the Youth Center will meet the students and walk them through the back gate.
- Back Gate Walkers @ 2:50: A faculty member from each grade level will escort students to the back gate area. Students who are permitted to walk unaccompanied will be released first. Parents picking up their children will wait on the Naval Base side of the gate (parents will not enter the campus). Parents will gather according to the directives of the Military Police. When you arrive to the front of the line, the Military Police Officer will announce your child's name and then your child will be released to meet you at the gate.
