

## Band Supply List 2019-2020

### First Year band students and Returning students in Band 1 or Band 2

should have the following items in class every day **AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN PLACED ON AN INSTRUMENT!**

- **\*Band Book:** Essential Elements 2000, Book 1, **FOR THEIR INSTRUMENT**
- **Instrument** and all necessary playing equipment and supplies (see below AFTER instrument assigned!)
- 1 ½ inch or 2-inch **BLACK 3 ring binder**
- ONE package (50 or more) 3 ring binder **sheet protectors!** (Larger supply suggested!)
- **Pencils** (Mechanical/ Fine point recommended)

### 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year band students in Band 3

should have the following items in class every day beginning August 14, 2019.

- **\*Band Book:** Essential Elements 2000, **Book 2, FOR THEIR INSTRUMENT**
- **Instrument** and all necessary playing equipment (mouthpiece, reeds, neck strap, etc.) and supplies (see below)
- **1 ½ inch or 2-inch 3 ring binder:**
  - **White for Woodwinds,**
  - **Blue for Brass,**
  - **Red/Pink for Percussion**
- ONE package (50 or more) 3 ring binder **sheet protectors!** (Larger supply suggested!)
- **Pencils** (Mechanical/ Fine point recommended)

*\*Books can be purchased through and are generally in stock at any local music store (Music & Arts, Music Man, Guitar Center, Etc). or Amazon.com*

#### **In Class supplies by instrument:**

**Flute:** Cleaning rod and cloth

**All clarinets and saxophones:** 4 to 6 reeds (2.5 strength or stronger) cleaning swab, cork grease, neck strap (Sax)

**Trumpet, baritone/euphonium, tuba:** valve oil, and tuning slide grease

**Trombone:** Tuning slide grease, slide oil or cream, and a small spray bottle

**Percussion:** SD1 drumsticks, 6" or larger practice pad AND STAND. All other mallets and beaters will be provided. If unable to purchase a practice pad and stand, a percussion kit must be acquired (Rented or purchased from music store or online), Only the kit with the practice pad is needed. Do NOT bring SNARE kits to school.
