

Mayport Coastal Sciences Middle School is excited to offer the GATE Program for the 2019-2020 School Year. This program is designed to meet the needs and abilities of our Gifted and Academically Talented students.

Students that qualify to participate in the GATE program, will receive a three-year educational plan on the Pre-AP track. They will have access to Gifted teachers in all their core classes, who will

provide an enriched and challenging curriculum. Upon their exit from 8th grade, students will have the opportunity to receive up to <u>five</u> high school credits from Algebra I, Geometry, Biology, Spanish I, Aquaculture, and Advanced Information Technology. GATE students will also have the option of taking two dedicated electives. The first is the GATE Inquiry Lab, which will have an emphasis on public service, leadership, and enrichment activities with like-minded learners; the second is Engineering & Technology Design, where students will explore STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) concepts through collaborative and small group learning labs.
