

Brick & Mortar End-of-Year Testing Information

State Assessments: Florida Standard Assessments (FSA) and End-of-Course Exams (EOC)

- Per state requirements, all students must take their state exams on the school campus.
- Students enrolled in the following courses will have a state assessment:
 - Algebra 1 (not including Algebra 1-A)
 - Geometry (Standard and Honors)
 - Biology (Standard and Honors)
 - US History (Honors and AP)
 - English 1 Honors (Grade 9) and English 2 Honors (Grade 10)
- FSA Algebra 1, FSA Geometry, EOC Biology and EOC US History count as 30% of the student's final yearlong average
- A passing score (Level 3 or higher) on the FSA Algebra 1 is a graduation requirement
- A passing score (Level 3 or higher) on the 10th grade FSA Reading/Writing is a graduation requirement
- Brick & Mortar students will test as follows:

FSA Writing (9 th /10 th)	Tuesday, April 20 th
US History EOC	Monday, May 17 th
Biology EOC	Tuesday, May 18 th
FSA Reading (9 th /10 th), Section 1	Thursday, May 20 th
FSA Reading (9 th /10 th), Section 2	Friday, May 21 st
FSA Algebra 1 & Geometry, Section 1	Monday, May 24 th
FSA Algebra 1 & Geometry, Section 2	Tuesday, May 25 th

- Students are encouraged to be on time to school as testing will begin promptly at 8:30am. We will not be able to test students who arrive late.

District End-of-Course Exams (DEOCs)

- Most courses that do not have a state EOC will have a District EOC*
- DEOCs count for 20% of the student's final average for semester 2
- The testing window for DEOCs is as follows:
 - Seniors April 5 - 23
 - Underclassmen April 19 - May 7
- Teachers will schedule the date for their exam with the Test Coordinator
- Teachers will announce their testing date to their classes

*Courses that do not have a state or district exam include Research 1-3; Executive Intern 1, 2, 3, 4; most AP and Dual Enrollment Courses
