

Duval HomeRoom End-of-Year Testing Information

State Assessments: Florida Standard Assessments (FSA) and End-of-Course Exams (EOC)

- Per state requirements, all students must take their state exams on the school campus.
- Students enrolled in the following courses will have a state assessment:
 - Algebra 1 (not including Algebra 1-A)
 - Geometry (Standard and Honors)
 - Biology (Standard and Honors)
 - US History (Honors and AP)
 - English 1 Honors (Grade 9) and English 2 Honors (Grade 10)
- FSA Algebra 1, FSA Geometry, EOC Biology and EOC US History count as 30% of the student's final yearlong average
- A passing score (Level 3 or higher) on the FSA Algebra 1 is a graduation requirement
- A passing score (Level 3 or higher) on the 10th grade FSA Reading/Writing is a graduation requirement
- DHR students will test separately from Brick & Mortar students as follows:

- Students will need to park or be dropped off in the faculty lot in front of the cafeteria on San Diego Road and should plan to arrive between 15 and 30 minutes prior to the start of the test. Students will have their temperature taken upon entering the school and must wear a mask the entire time on campus.
- Testing will start on time. We will not be able to accommodate late arrivals.

District End-of-Course Exams (DEOCs)

- Most courses that do not have a state EOC will have a District EOC*
- DEOCs count for 20% of the student's final average for semester 2
- DHR students will take their DEOCs remotely from home
- The testing window for DEOCs is as follows:
 - Seniors April 5 - 23
 - Underclassmen April 19 - May 7
- Teachers will schedule the date for their exam with the Test Coordinator
- Teachers will post their testing date on their class Teams page

*Courses that do not have a state or district exam include Research 1-3; Executive Intern 1, 2, 3, 4; most AP and Dual Enrollment Courses
