Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) requires students enrolled in Algebra I, Geometry, Biology, US History, and Civics to take an End-of-Course (EOC) exam which constitutes 30% of a student's final grade. The FDOE has not released the EOC results for these courses at this time.

In an effort to ensure that students receive grade information in a timely manner, report cards will be issued prior to the release of EOC scores. Because these EOCs only impact four high school courses and one middle school course, the decision was made to provide the report cards to families at the end of the school year.

Once EOC results are available, grades will be recalculated for students enrolled in these five courses during the 2018-2019 school year using the EOC score as 30% of the final grade. Based on students' State EOC performance, grades on the report card may improve for these courses. A new report card will be made available for the students impacted by these courses. A notice will be placed in the "Focus Messages" area when the updated report card can be accessed via the Parent Portal. Additionally, we have included a help guide on how to access this information electronically.
