Record Breakers

- We had the highest gains of Proficiency in ELA and Math in DCPS.
- We were 4th in the state for growth out of 2,088 schools.
- We are leading the ISI Region in grade level areas and gains even those who earned B school grades this year.

Challenge(s) of Practice

What points did we leave on the table?

- Science decreased by 12 pts.
- 42 students did not grow in ELA
- 23 students did not grow in Math

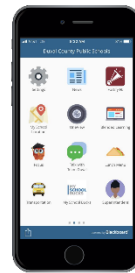
Free lunches will be held in the school quad. Please make sure you get your food tickets at the door!
