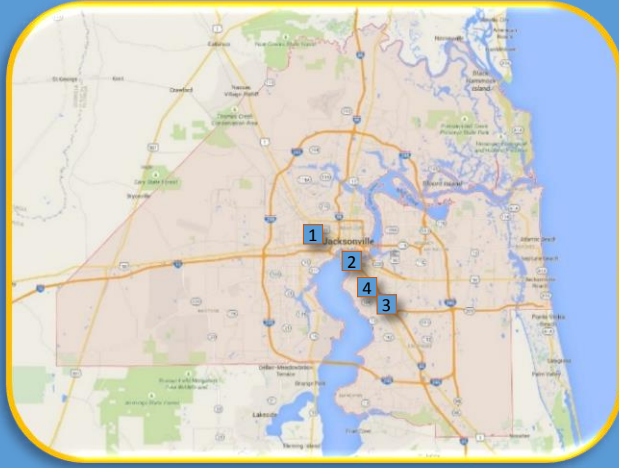


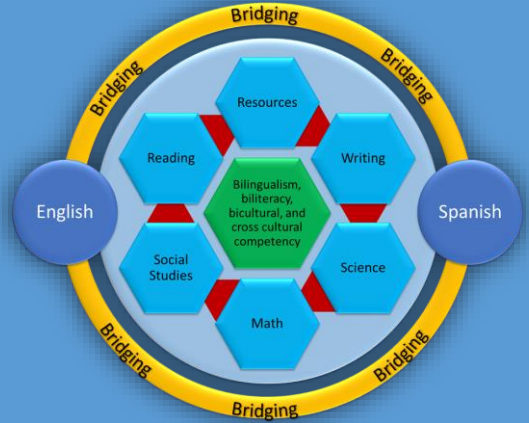

2 - San Jose Elementary 4 - DuPont Middle

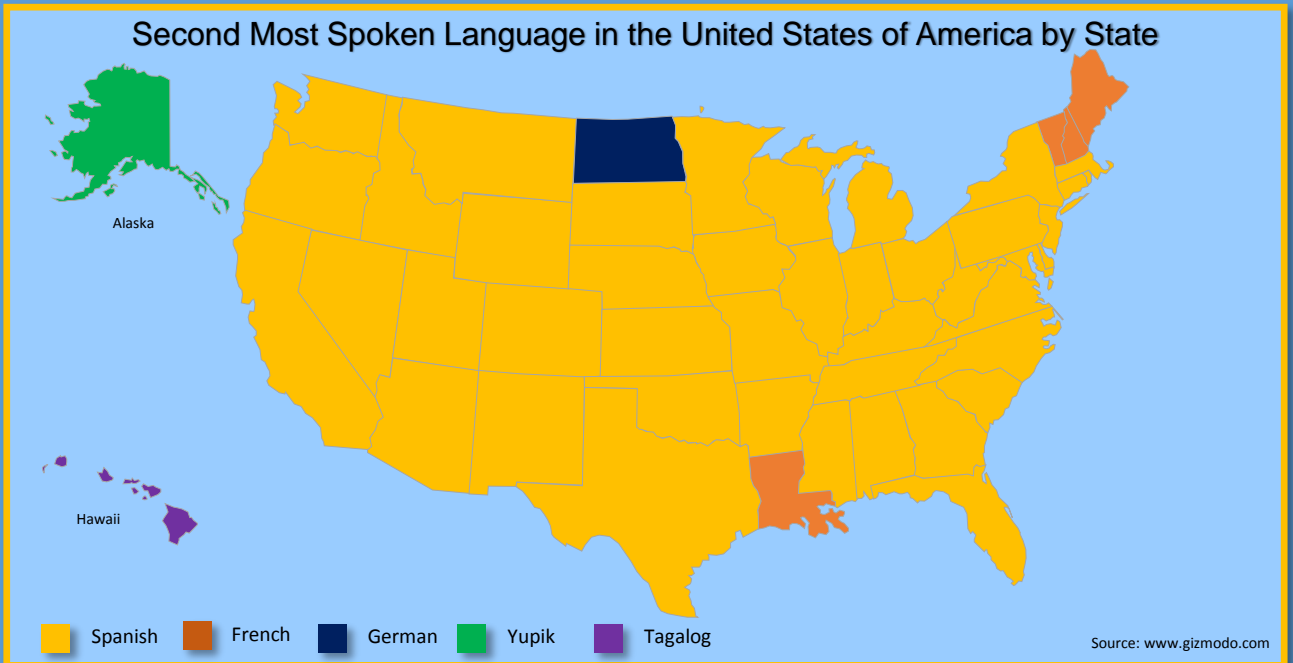
How Dual Language Program Works?
