- * On track to graduate with a minimum unweighted 2.0 GPA
- * Achieved Senior status
- * Completed or enrolled in a Dual Enrollment course by the fall 2021 **OR** has passed an AP exam or CTE exam.
- * Passed FSA & EOC requirements or earned appropriate concordant scores Attach score report.
- * Taken a College Ready Test (PERT, ACT, or SAT) **AND** has post-secondary ready scores in math and reading.
- * Has proof of transportation (Including parking pass, driver's license, and proof of insurance)

Please be advised that a partial schedule may impact college admissions and scholarship opportunities.

Students and parents/guardians agree that all rules and regulations of Duval County School Board and Atlantic Coast High School (as stated in the Secondary Code of Conduct) shall be followed:

- Students will only be on campus during scheduled class or extracurricular activity times.
- Students will leave in an authorized vehicle.
- Students will not be allowed to walk off campus.
- Students will maintain grades aligned with a 2.0 GPA. Grade reviews will take place throughout the year.
- Students must carry the appropriate Student ID at all times when on campus.

Failure to follow these rules will result in the loss of their partial schedule privileges.

Your signature below enables your student to leave campus at the appropriate day and time. This is an official checkout releasing ACHS from liability during the time they are off campus. **This is a privilege, therefore, it can be suspended or revoked at any time if deemed necessary by an ACHS administrator.**

Note re: Uber & Lyft

Students who are on senior leave are not eligible to leave campus using Uber or Lyft services unless they are 18 years old. Below are statements from both companies regarding unaccompanied minors.

Uber Unaccompanied Minors Rule – "A rider must be at least 18 years of age to have an Uber account and request rides. Anyone under 18 must be accompanied by someone 18 years of age or older on any ride."

Lyft Unaccompanied Minors Rule – "Unaccompanied minors are prohibited from traveling with most carriers, including TNCs. A passenger must be 18 to sign up for the Lyft account, but if a driver believes a passenger might be underage, the driver may ask the passenger to confirm their age."
