ARRIVAL

- Car drop off is to the side of the building in the loop
- ♦ Car rider loop is open 8a-8:25a
- DO <u>NOT</u> drop students off before 8a.

 There is no adult supervision and students will not be able to access building
- -Students are expected to be ON TIME and in their seats ready to learn when the bell rings at 8:30a
- Students arriving after 8:30 must use

DISMISSAL

- -NO students may be checked out after 2:15p (per district policy)
- -Dismissal begins at 2:45p . This year we will be utilizing PIKMYKID application for a faster dismissal process . See page 3
- -Students not enrolled in after school programs must be picked up no later than 3:05p

Do You Have a Desire to Volunteer?

Visitor / Volunteer Application—DCPS REQUIRED

Duval County Public Schools requires <u>all volunteers and visitors</u> to register and be screened. This include anyone that would like to visit classrooms, chaperone, or have lunch with their child (where applicable). Once processed the application stays on file for 2 years. Processing takes 5-10 days. We suggest you complete NOW. It is a quick and easy process.

Get Started

The app is available for download. Search " Pikmykid" on your smartphone's app store (Google-Play, Windows or iTunes).

Registration

Once you have downloaded the PikMyKid phone app, you will press the "Sign Up" button and fill out the form.

OTP Code

After you press submit, you will be sent an OTP code by text message. Please enter this code into the next screen. This will complete your registration process!

Don't see your child?

If you are a parent/guardian and see a blank screen, please contact support@pikmykid.com to correct the issue. It is likely that the school did not have your mobile number on file.

Each parent & user will need to register on their own smartphone with their own information.

Q How do I change my child's Pick Up Mode?

- Open the Pikmykid app and click the pencil icon next to the school name. Then select the blue edit button next to your child's name. A new colendar page with student information will then be visible. Choose the date on the calendar, select "Change Pick Up Mode" and continue.
- Select your child's new pick up mode from the drop down menu and decide if it is a recurring change—if so, for how long and how often (weekly, daily, monthly etc).
- 3. Press Done! You and the school will now be able to see the change on your child's calendar!

Q How do I allow someone else to pick up my child?

- Open the Pikmykid app and click the pencil icon next to the school name. Then select the blue edit button next to your child's name. A new calendar page with student information will then be visible. Choose the date on the calendar, select "Delegate" and continue.
- Enter the person's name and mobile number from your contact list. From the drop down mens select how they will be picking up your child and decide if it is a recurring change—if so, for how long and how often (weekly, daily, monthly etc).
- 3. Press Donel You and the school will now be able to see the change on your child's calendar!

Q How do I announce my arrival to the school?

Parents can only announce during your school's set dismissal hours for car riders or walk ups.

 Make sure your phone's location services are on and the toggle switch next to your student's name is green.

3. Stop at the stop sign and click the GREEN ANNOUNCE

From the menu (IIII) in the top right corner of the app , select "Support". Fill out and submit the form to be connected with a friendly customer service human.
