Hello Stingray Nation!

As a reminder, there is no school tomorrow, Monday, March 22nd. There will also be no after school drivers ed tomorrow. Class will resume on Tuesday March 23rd.

As we report new cases of COVID-19 to the Department of Health, these may result in further contact tracing. If your student is affected, you will be notified from the Department of Health. If you are experiencing COVID symptoms, please stay home and call the school for further clarification.

Report cards will be posted in Focus on Monday, March 29th. Parents will be able to see student report cards in the Parent Focus Portal.

If you have not completed your course requests for the 2021/2022 school year, please reach out to your school counselor as soon as possible. Students who do not complete a course request will not have a choice in their elective classes next year.

Juniors mark your calendars: Tuesday, April 13th is the School Day SAT. This is your free opportunity to participate in the SAT that is reportable to colleges. It can also be used to meet your math and reading test graduation requirements. There is no need to register, your tests have already been ordered for you.

Our first state assessment testing day is just around the corner! On Wednesday, April 7th, we will be conducting the FSA Writing assessment for our freshmen, sophomores, and our juniors who still need to pass their 10th grade assessment. The school testing dates are on our calendar on the school website in pink if you'd like to look ahead.

ASVAB scores are in! Stop by Ms. Menard's office room 103 to pick them up.

Seniors don't forget that prom tickets are on sale until March 25th. All students attending prom need to bring a signed prom waiver to purchase their ticket. Tickets cost \$55 and can be purchased from Coach Rowan in room 336 before and after school and during all lunches. Members of the Stingray senior package already have a ticket to prom but still need to submit a prom waiver. If you are a member of the Stingray package and can no longer attend prom, you may submit a refund request. Refund requests are due to Ms. Solomon no later than 2pm on Tuesday, March 23rd. Copies of the prom waiver and refund requests can be found on the ACHS website and in room 336 with Coach Rowan.

There are less than 100 tickets remaining for this years Grad Bash trip to Universal on Friday, April 23rd. Tickets cost \$165 and can be purchased in room 104. Only cash can be accepted. Reach out to Ms. Solomon if you have any questions.

Registration for the summer sessions of drivers ed is after school only on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays from 3 to 5:30pm. Students must have a restricted license or a learners permit by the time the class starts. The class costs \$160 and only cash will be accepted. Registration must be completed in person.
