Hello Stingray Nation!

We will continue to keep you updated as we report new cases of COVID-19 to the Department of Health. These may result in further contact tracing, if your student is affected, you will be notified from the Department of Health. Please stay home and call the school for further clarification if you are experiencing COVID symptoms.

Graduating seniors who did not participate in the graduation ceremony may pick up their diplomas Monday through Friday, 8am - 2pm.

As a reminder, there is no school tomorrow, Monday, May 31st.

We will continue our early release schedule this week. Students will be released at 11am and we will continue on the skinny schedule that began last Thursday. Please remember that students will not be able to carry backpacks on campus. Any backpack brought onto campus will be confiscated until the end of the day. Students who would like lunch on early release days will be allowed to pick up a bagged lunch before 11am dismissal. If students want lunch, they will be required to pick up a wristband in the morning in the cafeteria from 6:45am – 7:15am.

On-campus students who have textbooks can turn them in when entering campus. Carts will be placed at the bus and car rider entrances for textbook collection. Duval Homeroom students who have textbooks to return can drop them off Tuesday, June 1st, from 8am to 10am in the front circle.

9th, 10th, and 11th grade final grades will not be available until the second week in June. Once final grades are available, students and parents will be able to see an updated GPA, credits, and promotion status through their FOCUS portal. Because the semester is not yet finished, this information is not available in either FOCUS or through the counseling office. Students or parents that have questions about grades can find individual teacher contact information on the ACHS website.

Be sure you are checking the ACHS website frequently throughout the summer for updates on all things AC.

The AC Counselors' Guide to Summer drops on June 3rd. The summer PERT schedule will also be released on June 3rd. Continue to check the Counseling section on the AC website for important info!

The AC website has a registration link posted for free ACT Prep sessions this summer. Sign up quickly as space is limited.

Just a reminder - ONLY SENIORS are required to turn in their laptops before the end of the school year. If you will be returning to Atlantic Coast next year or if you will be transferring to another DCPS school, this laptop stays with you until you graduate. If you know you will be

moving out of the district or state, please make sure to turn in your laptop to have it cleared from your student accounts when you are properly withdrawing.
