Students interested in being executive interns for the 2021-2022 school year need to complete the application on the ACHS website. Any student applying for an Executive Intern position must have the following criteria:

1. Be a senior and on track for graduation.
2. Have a cumulative Grade Point Average (G.P.A.) of at least 2.5.
3. Have no documented office referrals in your file (No Class 2 or 3).
4. Have a good attendance record from the previous school year.

Eligible students can submit applications through Friday, August 13th

The summer PERT schedule is currently available on the AC website under Stingray Info. There you will also find the registration link for free ACT Prep sessions being hosted on campus this summer. Be sure to sign up for the prep sessions quickly as space is limited.

For the 2021-2022 school year, all PE classes will be dressing out and using the locker rooms. The dress out policy at Atlantic Coast includes the following:

1. Mandatory PE shirt (sold for \$10).
2. All black bottoms of student's choice: shorts, joggers, leggings, capris. Bottoms must be dress code appropriate.
3. Closed toe tennis shoes/athletic shoes.

We have some shirts on hand currently and will make them available in the ACHS Spirit Store through T5 Sports. If a student has the shirt from a previous year, they are allowed to wear it. It is grey with the AC logo in orange. If anyone has any questions, they can reach out to Coach Keane or any of the PE coaches.

Transcripts for graduating seniors will not be final until the 3rd week in June. Students who completed the Post-Secondary Senior survey for graduation indicated where they wanted to send their final transcripts and, once available, ACHS will automatically send your records to your chosen school. Colleges and Universities usually do not require final transcripts for students to participate in Freshmen Orientation or summer programs as they are aware of our District grading timelines. Please be reminded that School Counselors do not have the ability to send official transcripts. After the 3rd week in June, if you still need to request final

As a reminder, graduating seniors have been given an extension on meeting the testing requirements for Bright Futures. The Bright Futures Scholarship application must be completed by August 31, 2021. Final evaluations will include ACT or SAT exams taken by December 1, 2021.
