The motion was seconded by Don Lauro.</p> <p>All present were voted in as members with the following exceptions:            Jennifer Martinez            Yagoub Elmanhi            Rena Mendez</p> <p>Voting for Officers;</p> <p>Don Redman was nominated to be the 1920 SAC Chairperson by Linda Dyke. Vote passed unanimously.</p> <p>Jennifer Hammock was nominated to be the 1920 SAC Vice Chairperson by Vasco Eagle. Vote passed unanimously.</p> <p>The AP is appointed by the Principal. Non-voting member.</p>
<p><b>Approve May 2019 SAC Minutes</b></p>	<p>Vasco Eagle moved to approve the minutes and Linda Dyke seconded the motion.            Approval of the May 2019 minutes passed.</p>

<p><b>1920 District SAC</b></p>	<p>Mr. Redman attended the 8/26/2019 meeting. Mr. Redman stated that School Facilities was the topic with an emphasis on the half cent sales tax.</p> <p>Vasco Eagle asked if Englewood is a part of the plan for improvement. Ms. Bravo responded that we have been slated for \$23,000,000 in improvements.</p> <p>Mr. Eagle asked questions pertaining to the half-cent sales tax and available literature or information. Mr. Redman stated there is not additional information at the present time. The City Council will be addressing the issue at tonight's meeting. The decision will be whether or not to allow the citizens to vote on the sales tax.</p> <p>Mr. Redman said the issue may be on the ballot in November as a referendum.</p>
<p><b>2019-2020 School Improvement Plan</b></p>	<p>Mrs. Bravo said that she has put Assistant Principal Stacey Johnson in charge of the plan for this year and the first draft has been submitted. Mrs. Bravo further stated that two goals were identified for the plan and those goals will be shared at next month's SAC meeting.</p>
<p><b>EHS Highlight</b></p>	<p>Mrs. Bravo re-introduced the idea of an EHS highlight shared at each monthly meeting. All SAC members agreed they would like that tradition to continue. Some suggested highlights shared by Mrs. Bravo were the JROTC Program, the Early College Program, Performing Arts, Dual Language, The CSS Program and the ESOL Program. Linda Dyke suggested the CSS Program be highlighted in September.</p>

<p><b>Principal's Report/Opening of School Overview</b></p>	<p>Mrs. Bravo shared a presentation outlining the Vision and Mission of Englewood High School. Also reviewed were the 1819 school data points, and initiatives and celebrations for the new school year.</p> <p>Specific time was taken to discuss the state-mandated 5 hours of Mental Health instruction for all 6-12 students. Duval County students will be receiving this instruction in 30 minute increments during Early Release Wednesdays, or "Wellness Wednesdays".</p> <p>Alison Kearley made a suggestion to include Full Service Schools as a part of the Mental Health Lessons (letting everyone know the services offered by Full Service Schools as a part of the process was discussed at the District SAC Meeting.</p> <p>Additional time was taken by Mrs. Bravo to outline the additional safety and security measures taken as part of the state mandate and shared the plans for additional monthly drills, metal detectors, threat assessment procedures and classroom safety procedures.</p>
<p><b>Closing</b></p>	<p>Next SAC Meeting Date: Tuesday, September 24<sup>th</sup> at 5:30 p.m.</p> <p>Mrs. Bravo provided details about Open House, scheduled for Monday, September 9<sup>th</sup>. Ms. Funes asked if there would be translators available at the Open House. Mrs. Bravo shared there would be six paraprofessionals present to translate. Mrs. Bravo also asked for volunteers to recruit additional SAC members at the SAC table that evening.</p> <p>Ms. Hammock made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Mr. Eagle seconded the motion.
