## **New Business:**

1. Introduction of Assistant Principal, Torra Talbott – Ms. Lott introduced Mrs. Torra Talbott to the SAC. Mrs. Talbott comes to S. A. Hull from Raines High School with a strong math and science background and proven leadership skills.
2. Faculty and Staff Changes – Ms. Lott informed the SAC that S. A. Hull has a new teacher on first grade. Ms. Brittany Wivholm is replacing Ms. Melissa Maxwell who transferred out of county. Mrs. Theresa Stewart is the new art teacher and Ms. Seybert the previous art teacher is moving to fourth grade to teach English Language Arts. The previous Media Specialist Mr. B. has retired and is now a SAC member. Ms. Nicole Bryant is the new Media Specialist. Mrs. Strickland the former fourth grade ELA teacher will now serve as the reading interventionist.
3. Election of Officers – Last year's SAC president informed members that the chairperson, vice chairperson and secretary were elected positions and ballots would be provided for each position. Members were first provided with ballots to elect the chairperson. Mrs. Curtrina Brown was elected chair. Ballots were provided for the vice chair position. Mr. Terry Butts was elected vice chair. Ballots were provided for secretary. Mrs. Margarett Roberts was elected secretary.
4. School Advisory Council Bylaws – Ms. Curtrina Brown reviewed the SAC bylaws with the committee. She asked for comments or questions. None were raised.
5. Principal's Report 2014 FCAT Results – Ms. Lott and Ms. Talbott went over the FCAT results from 2014. Each member received a copy of the results. Ms. Lott stated that the overall number of accountability points increased and S. A. Hull was only 17 points away from receiving a 'B'. Ms. Talbott shared the math results with the committee, pointing out the 95% of the lowest performing students showed improvement in math, 75% of overall students demonstrated improvement in math, and almost 60% of all students tested were proficient in math.
6. Principal's Report New State Assessment (Florida Standards Assessment) – Ms. Lott informed the committee that a new assessment will be used in the spring to assess students in reading and math. She stated that the FCAT will still be used as the performance measure for 5<sup>th</sup> grade science. As information about the new assessment becomes available, she will provide the members with updates.
