

MORNING TARDY POLICY

The following **Tardy to School Procedure** will be followed at Englewood High School for the 2015-2016 school year. Students will not be marked for a <u>morning</u> tardy until Monday, August 31, the first day of the second week of school. <u>Starting on that date, the following tardy policy will be followed.</u>

According to the Student Code of Conduct, tardiness is defined as "the physical absence of a student in the classroom at the beginning of a regularly scheduled session at which he or she is scheduled to be present... A student has the responsibility to be in class on time. A student failing to make an effort to attend class in a timely manner shall be considered truant and subject to disciplinary action. Accumulation of tardies shall be based on a nine week grading period."

A student at EHS is considered tardy if s/he is not present <u>inside the classroom</u> when the bell rings at 7:15 a.m. Tardy students are to report to Mr. Jenkins or a security guard at the Attendance Window to receive a tardy slip before entering class late. All tardies are documented through the school's electronic tracking system.

Consequences for Tardiness:

1st through 4th tardy: Student notification by way of tardy slip. The third tardy slip will have a warning notice printed on it.

 5^{th} – 7^{th} Tardy: Student assigned afternoon detention. Student reports to Dean to discuss importance of being on time to school.

8th Tardy: Student reports to Dean of Discipline for parent contact and further consequences which could include a discipline referral and In School Suspension.

9th Tardy (or more): Parent conference is requested and may involve a representative from the district truancy office along with the principal and school resource officer.

Administration reserves the right to contact the district truancy office if a student's tardy occurrences are deemed excessive over the course of a nine weeks period.

ALL STUDENTS ENTERING THE BUILDING AFTER 7:15 a.m. MUST REPORT TO THE ATTENDANCE WINDOW FOR A TARDY PASS.

These tardy procedures begin anew at the beginning of each quarter.
