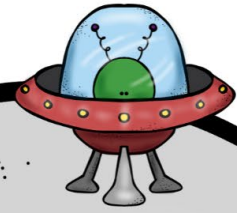

### COVID-19 Policy

If a student or employee tests positive, they may not return to school until:

- The student/employee receives a negative diagnostic COVID-19 test and is asymptomatic; or
- Five (5) days have passed since the onset of symptoms or positive test result, the student/employee has been fever-free for 24 hours and the other symptoms are improving;
- A negative test is NOT required in order to return to school/work

If a family member tests positive and the student DOES NOT have any symptoms, they may come to school.

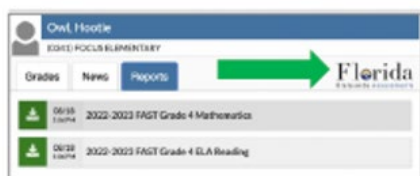
