Stanton College Preparatory School SAC Meeting Minutes March 23, 2022

Attendance: Members present as noted on the sign-in sheet for Stanton College Preparatory School (hereinafter referred to as Stanton) School Advisory Council (SAC) and sign-in sheet for the community, stakeholders, including parents.

Call to Order: A meeting of the Stanton College Preparatory School Advisory Council 7 held in the media center on March 23, 2022. Kenyatta Register, called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. Catherine Spears recorded the minutes for the meeting.

Welcome: Kenyatta Register welcomed all in attendance to the meeting. Participants introduced themselves.

Adoption of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved as printed. The motion passed at 3:35 p.m.

Quorum: Eight of ten Elected Board members are present (six is required for voting) therefore a quorum was formed. The current By-laws allows for a maximum of 30 Board members.

Minutes from Previous Meeting: Minutes from the February 23, 2021 meeting were motioned and seconded for approval as a quorum was formed at this meeting. The unanimously approved minutes will be subsequently submission to the District School Improvement Office.

Report from PTSA: A report was not made by Robin Strickland, PTSA/SAC Liaison due to her excused absent.

School Improvement Fund (SIF) Report: Dave Karrmann reported that there is no change in fund balance. The current year ending balance is \$3,610.92 as the date of this meeting.

Principal's Report:

Principal Majova reported the Robotics teams has advanced to National Champions and need assistance with sponsorship. Congratulations to Nila Fields as one of the three sunshine states scholars. Stanton's 19 Merit Scholars will receive recognition at the April DCPS Board meeting. Stanton's Drama Club attended the Florida Drama Competition in Tampa over Spring break and received awards level ratings. First time in Stanton's history, the Chorus received a superior rating at the State competition. FSA writing is scheduled for April 5th. School wide SAT Test is April 13th for11th graders. This is the last year for FSA. Accountability results graphed for the school's total points of 762 (A rating - compared to 850 prior year) show ELA, Reading Gains, ELA Bottom Quartile Gains, Math Proficiency, Math Gains, Math Bottom Quartile Gains, Science Proficiency,

Social Studies Proficiency, Graduation Rate, and Acceleration Rate. Through out Stanton's history the school was rated as a "A" exception for in the year 2000. Volunteers are needed to assisting for the upcoming FSA, AP, and IB testing. Spring clean up will take place on April 9th. Former Staton students will attend a Fish Fry the same day to celebrate the "Old" Stanton School.
