School Improvement Fund (SIF) Report: Dave Karrmann reported that the balance as of May was \$3,610.92 pending disbursement to purchase new planners for the 2022-2022 academic year. The disbursement will clear out fund however expecting SIF money next year.

Principal Majova reported still ongoing exams May 19th for those with schedule conflicts. Testing subjects included AP LANG, Human Geography, Physics, Art History, French Lang, Latin, French HL/SL, Calculus AB/ BC, Macroeconomics, Physics 2, Spanish Lang HL, Music Theory, Us Government, Ap European History, AP LANG, Comparative Government, Macroeconomics, Biology, Physics 1, and Calculus.
