## **SAC Meeting Minutes February 20, 2019 – MID-YEAR STAKEHOLDERS MEETING**

**Call to Order:** A meeting of the Stanton College Preparatory School Advisory Council was held in the Media Center at Stanton on February 20, 2019. Ms. Majova facilitated the presentation on the Mid-Year Review data. Areas covered in the presentation include:

- Reading
  - Presented by Ms. Ennis and Mr. Moore.
  - Data analyzed to determine trends. Plan will be developed and implemented after Spring Break.
  - We have afterschool workshops to help students pass Algebra I FSA (for those who need to take this test). We also have workshops that offer test taking strategies as well as a geometry lab. Our goal is to pass all students that need to take the Algebra I FSA in 9<sup>th</sup> grade.
- Gains R&M
- Lowest Performing Quartile Gains R&M
- Geometry
- Biology
  - Presented by Ms. Farmer and Ms. Hornilla.
  - We look at our baseline and standards to identify the lowest performers and add enrichment activities for these students. We cover required standards to pass the EOC and ensure they are prepared for higher level courses.
- APUSH (AP US History)
  - We teach AP course, starting with the Colonial Period.
  - We prepare students for the EOC and AP exams.
- Graduation Rate
  - Last year, our graduation rate was 100%.
- Acceleration
  - Acceleration is 98%
  - All A & B schools are expected to gain 11 points (need to be at 861 points).
