#### SAC Meeting Minutes April 20, 2016

**Attendance -** Members present as noted on the sign in sheet for Stanton SAC and sign in sheet for the community, stakeholders, including parents.

Call to Order - A meeting of the Stanton College Preparatory School Advisory Council was held in the Media Center at the school on April 20, 2016. Larry Cobb, 2015-16 SAC chairperson, called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. Margery Barnhart, 2015-2016 Secretary, recorded the minutes for the meeting.

**Welcome** - Larry Cobb announced that 55 Stanton students have received National Merit Scholar recognition. He congratulated the students for this high achievement. He also recognized the excellent administration, faculty and staff of Stanton for all they do for the Stanton students.

Susan Arthur, representative from the Dallas Graham Branch Library, requested that students not park in the front of the library. As per Ms. Majova's request, the school is to be notified when students park at the library. They have been instructed to not use the library parking lot.

Minutes - Minutes for March 2016 meeting were reviewed and approved.

- Our website is now **Multicultural!** Along the left side is an option to "SELECT LANGUAGE" and the entire site will be translated into whichever of the nearly SIXTY languages you select!
- PTSA had a very successful partnering with the Multicultural Extravaganzas, providing multicultural
  food trucks for both nights, flags of the countries and welcome signs in the languages of the diverse
  population of our students, and their families, and a World Map and guest book where students and
  families marked their heritage with glow-in-the-dark pushpins and messages about their family
  names and countries of origin.

Discussion was held after the PTSA report and a request was made to have a link from the Stanton website to the PTSA website.

SIF Report - Purnima Ganju reported that there is no change from the report of the March 2016 meeting. As of this date funds have not been received from the state.

**Faculty Forum Report** - Till Bagby reported that the funds have not been received from the state as of this date. Funds roll over from year to year.

#### Principal's Report: Student and School Recognition:

- National Merit Scholars 55 students. Ms. Majova read each name to the SAC members. She
  congratulated these students for this outstanding accomplishment. Finalists will be announced in
  November. A back yard bar-b-q honoring all Stanton students will be held April 27.
- PSAT 7 Hispanic National Merit students (they are in the top 2.5% of Hispanic students in the nation)
- Gates Millennium Award recipient 1 student
- US News and World Report- Stanton ranked as follows:
  - #31 National Ranking Best High Schools (5<sup>th</sup> in Florida);
  - #8 Magnet Schools Best High Schools (nation)
- Washington Post Stanton ranked as follows in America's Most Challenging Schools category:
  - #7 in Nation
  - # #3 in the South
  - #1 in Florida

#### Ms. Majova reported on the following:

- 161 IB students have been accepted for 2016-17.
- Stanton's Bridge program will be held June 15-17 and June 22-24.
- Best Practices Teachers from other schools will come to Stanton and share IB and AP plans for next year. This will be held June 15-17.
- Students picked their classes for 2016-17 on the computer. They will meet with counselors next week to review choices.
- Congratulations to boys' and girls' tennis teams for making it to the state competition and to the lacrosse team for going to the regional competition.
- · Random safety searches are being conducted.
- Testing: 10<sup>th</sup> grade reading, geometry and Algebra II; district exams next week.

#### **Old Business:**

- Mentoring Program: Lyn McKenzie reported that the paperwork had been returned from the state as additional information was needed. She will review the documents with Kelli Klinger after the meeting. Once completed the forms will be notarized and mailed. Once the application is approved, they can move on with program implementation. Duval County Public Schools requests Level II for certification which requires additional background screening. It is anticipated that the program will kick off in the 2016-17 school year. Training sessions will possibly be conducted this summer. A sign-up sheet was circulated for those interested in being a part of the mentoring program.
- Friends of Stanton Wen Raiti expressed her thanks to Larry Cobb and Tammy Butler in their
  assistance in starting this program. In order to get this program started, a lot of help is needed.
   Various ways to get the information out to the public was discussed.
