Stanton College Preparatory School SAC Meeting Minutes November 16, 2022

Attendance: Members present as noted on the sign-in sheet for Stanton College Preparatory School (hereinafter referred to as Stanton) School Advisory Council (SAC) and sign-in sheet for the community, stakeholders, including parents.

Call to Order: A meeting of the Stanton College Preparatory School Advisory Council 7 held in the Stanton's Media Center on November 16, 2022. Kenyatta Register called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. Catherine Spears reported the minutes for the meeting.

Welcome: Kenyatta Register welcomed all in attendance to the meeting. Participants introduced themselves.

Adoption of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved as printed. The motion passed at 3:35 p.m.

Quorum: Eleven out of the twelve Elected Board members are present (seven is required for voting) therefore a quorum was formed. A request was made to verify the quorum from the October 19, 2022 meeting. As a result, one elected member relinquished their seat. A discuss and replacement vote will take place at the next meeting. The current By-laws allows for a maximum of 30 Board members.

Minutes from Previous Meeting: Minutes from the October 19, 2022 meeting were revised for the number of attending board members followed by a motioned and seconded for approval as a quorum was formed at this meeting. The unanimously approved minutes will subsequently obtain submission to the District School Improvement Office.

Report from PTSA: PTSA representative, Cassia Brunner, reported that the Thanksgiving Pie drive is underway. Another parent bridge meeting is scheduled for the end of November. In December, the student wish list and kindness program will take place.

School Improvement Fund (SIF) Report: Dave Karrmann reported that the balance as of November is \$2.37.

Mr. Malloy took 10 students in the Crayon (Children of Color) program to the University of Florida to learn about scholarship opportunities and ways to apply for their schools of choice. Taste of IB have started tours for this year. The various sports teams are performing well. 208 students were induced into the National Honor Society ceremony held inside for the first time since Covid. Ms. Henricks and Ms. Melady are former Stanton graduates that are now 9th grade teachers at the school assisting students with the freshman process of transiting to Stanton, personality testing, and career placement testing. Mr. Malone reported on the testing schedule. The PSAT/SAT result will be available soon online via Focus or the student's PSAT/SAT account. The SA4 code is for the SAT scores in Focus. AMT12 is the United States Math test which selects students to represent the US in the Global Math Achieve

competition. This year's competition is in China. District and semester exams are forthcoming. Retakes for the Geometry, Biology, and US History end of course exam are available for those student who missed the exam due to Covid. Those exams are necessary for Honors designation. PMA2 is scheduled for January 4, 2023.

Student Government Associates (SGA) Update: The student book exchange program is in the implementation stage. Currently working with the Librarian for guidance and support.
