Wednesday was successfully conducted with 7 to 8 visitors from the District attending the various events. Middle schools recruitment visits are underway with Ms. Simmons' already visiting Landon and JWJ. The Taste of IB tours have started for the year. A tours is scheduled for this upcoming Thursday both virtually and in person. The 11th grade students took the Civics test (first time administered) achieving a 93 percent pass rate. Students who successfully pass the test will not have to take the exam in college. Winter fest will take place the last day of school prior to the break. Please follow up and encourage the students who are seniors about their eligibility for Bright Futures. National Honors Society inductions are tonight on the football field. The outdoor patio project is still experiencing temporary road blocks since the three vendor selected by the District are now requesting an Engineer to evaluate the drainage area which cost approximately an additional \$30,000.
