

# **Stanton College Preparatory School**

## **SAC Meeting Minutes**

### **October 20, 2021**

**Attendance:** Members present as noted on the sign-in sheet for Stanton College Preparatory School (hereinafter referred to as Stanton) School Advisory Council (SAC) and sign-in sheet for the community, stakeholders, including parents.

**Call to Order:** A meeting of the Stanton College Preparatory School Advisory Council 7 held in the media center on October 20, 2021. Kenyatta Register, called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. Catherine Spears recorded the minutes for the meeting.

**Welcome:** Kenyatta Register welcomed all in attendance to the meeting. Participants introduced themselves.

**Adoption of Agenda:** The agenda was unanimously approved as printed. The motion passed at 3:35 p.m.

**Quorum:** Eight of ten Elected Board members are present (six is required for voting) therefore a quorum was formed. The current By-laws allows for a maximum of 30 Board members.

**Minutes from Previous Meeting:** Minutes from the September 15, 2021 meeting were motioned by Dave Karrmann and Principal Majova-Seane seconded for approval as a quorum was formed at this meeting. The unanimously approved minutes will be subsequently submission to the District School Improvement Office.

**Report from PTSA:** A report was made by Robin Strickland, PTSA/SAC Liaison. School picture's make up day was yesterday. The photos are available online at Leonard's website for purchase. DCCPTA reported the following: masks mandate will continue for all schools, the number of "D" rated schools is improving (currently have 9 compared to 17 the prior year), and volunteers are now allowed on school campus with mask. PTSA is searching for a Beautification committee and chairperson to oversee the November 13th campus clean up event. The next general body meeting is scheduled for November 16, 2021.

**School Improvement Fund (SIF) Report:** A report was made by Dave Karrmann. There is no change to report. The current year ending balance is \$3,610.92 as the date of this meeting.

#### **Principal's Report:**

A copy of the principal's report can be obtained from Principal Nongongoma Majova-Seane's office upon request.

Principal Majova reported that the school is in compliance with the SIF reporting diversity requirements. PSAT testing was administered with over 97% of the 9th, 87% of 10th, and 97% of the 11th graders took the exam. PMA 1 Test results are available. Scores of 40% or lower are marked in red for the critical attention and required remediation. 41% to 66% is marked in yellow which indicates approaching proficiency. Results of 67% or higher are in the proficiency range. PMA 2 window opens between November 9, 2021 through December 17, 2021. Student Flu Shoots are scheduled for October 25, 2021. The District has provided a videographer to film the school's activities for recruiting purposes. AP Exam registration deadline for the Spring 2022 test is November 15, 2021. After November 15th there is a \$40 late fee.

Assistant Principal Micheal Kerr reported that the outdoor patio project has a temporary roadblock due to approval of the vendor select. The district is currently providing a list of approved vendors.

Guidance Counselor Misayo Watanabe reported that the 96% of freshman students were screened in their Great Books course for universal health survey mandated by the state due to the Marjory Stoneman Douglas Act which includes the following areas: conduct, academic functioning, social and cognitive negative impact. Based on the results, the counselors followed up with any students with indicators to ensure all was well with them. Ms. Ibasco reported that 77 Seniors attended a Financial Aid night at the school. The event was recorded and the PowerPoint is posted on the website. Beacon (Bring Economic and Career Opportunities Near) program has started which affords the Seniors a chance to meet individually (one on one) with a guidance counselor via virtually on Teams to assist with financial aid needs for college. College Apps sessions commenced in September and will run through December every Tuesday and Thursdays from 3:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. The sessions permit the student to work on their common application for colleges, essays, etc.
