**Call to Order:**

A meeting of the Stanton College Preparatory School Advisory Council was held in Media Center at the school on January 21, 2015. 2014-15 SAC-Vice Chair, Larry Cobb, called the meeting to order at 3:35 p.m. Loraine Rice, 2014-2015 Secretary, recorded the minutes for the meeting.

**Minutes:**

Minutes for January approved. Attendance of 1 member was listed twice under "not present".

**PTSA Report:**

Budget review is complete. Donations are decent, but they are below the anticipated amount. However, the PTSA does not foresee any issues for the remainder of the year. **Principal's Report:**

Participated in a New Tech City's Bored and Brilliant project—a broadcast was led by some student's voices and ideas. Student was accepted into John Hopkins. 2015 Presidential Scholars: D. Banerjee and P. Polineni. Stanton student was chosen as athlete of the week. 4 students were signed on college day. Latin awards were noted and several Stanton students were noted. State teams were identified along with special awards given to students. Reviewed state approved testing dates. FSA/FCAT started with writing first week of March, 11<sup>th</sup> graders are first. Parents need to be mindful of scheduling college visits during weeks of the IB testing. Dr. Haywood reviewed testing for exams. Memo was sent home with students assessments. Writing test is updated from the previous year; reviewing practice test (timed writing.) During the meeting an email was forwarded and read that the administration of the Grade 11 ELA FSA (including the Writing Component) will not be administered this year from the governor.

**New Business:**

Grant Library representative handed out flyers and discussed resources available for students on the library website. They work with the Parent Academy through DCSB. SAC member noted the 2015 Northeast Florida Lunar Chinese New Year Celebration on 2/22 at the Robinson Theater at UNF. It was noted that the IB and AP program information is available through the DCSB Magnet program site.
