RISING 9TH GRADE SCHEDULING INSTRUCTIONS (AICE ONLY)

Starting March 1, 2021, rising 9th graders who have been officially accepted into the Fletcher High School **AICE Program**, may submit their schedule request for the 2021-2022 school year. Please review the following guidelines for this process.

1. Review the AICE graduation requirements listed below.
2. Review the FHS 8th grade Transition Newsletter posted on the school website. This is a great resource and has imperative information about summer reading and assignments!
3. Continue to monitor our school website and social media pages for updates regarding orientation and other school related details. Additional contact information may be found on the school [website](#).
4. Complete the Microsoft Form titled, 9th Grade AICE Course Selection for Class of 2025. The link to this form is below.
 - Please make sure to review your choices carefully and **only submit one form per student**.
 - The Microsoft Form will clearly outline which core academic courses each student will need to take. Some core classes are required of all 9th grade AICE students and others may depend on current high school level classes being taken in the 8th grade.
 - Additional course options (electives) can be found on the guidance portion of the school website on the AICE Registration Card for 2021 - 2022. A list of potential courses for 9th grade AICE students is also provided on page 2 for your convenience. Please note that we use the same AICE scheduling card for 9th - 12th grade students and have courses listed for each grade level. Some of the course are only appropriate for 10th – 12th grade students. Courses that are academically appropriate for 9th grade AICE students are listed on page 2 of this document.

Math	4 credits: Algebra I, Geometry & Algebra II, + 1
Science	4 credits: Biology, at least one AICE or AP
Social Studies	3 credits: must be Level 3* courses, at least 1 AICE or AP
Global Perspectives	1 credit of AICE Global Perspectives
World Language	2 credits: must be in the same world language
Electives	6 credits (in addition to Global Perspectives)
Total Credits	24
Tests	State Reading Assessment, Algebra 1 EOC
GPA	2.0

*Level 3 courses are weighted courses that include Honors, AP, AICE, IB and Dual Enrollment
