

## Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. We do not live in your attendance area. How can I get my child into BSE?**  
Apply for the Special Transfer Option. You will need a Parent/Guardian account in FOCUS to access the form. We typically have a limited number of seats per grade level.
- 2. Are you offering in-person school tours?** Not at this time.
- 3. Is transportation provided?** Bus transportation is **not provided** to students who apply through the **Special Transfer Option**. Parents must provide transportation. **For students that live in our attendance area**, per Board policy Ch. 8.30.V, any student who resides more than 1.5 miles from his/her assigned school is eligible to ride the school bus to and from that school.
- 4. Do you have Extended Day?** Yes, check our website periodically between March – May for information regarding registration.
- 5. Do you have VPK?** No
- 6. What is your average class size?** In K – 2, 18-20. In 3-5, 22-24.
- 7. What type of resources/specials are offered at your school?** Art, Music, PE and Media
- 8. What type of support is in place for students with special needs?** Special Education is individualized based on each student's needs. We have various types of support ranging from support facilitation to resource pull-out implemented by our Varying Exceptionality Teachers. Students with disabilities are also provided accommodations and modifications based on their specific needs. For qualifying students, we offer support services for speech, language, occupational, and physical therapy.
- 9. What type of extracurricular activities are available to students?** Activities such as Accelerated Art, Musical Theater, Soccer, Lego Club are offered through our After-School Enrichment program. These classes are fee-based.
- 10. How can students be nominated for gifted consideration?** A student may be nominated for gifted screening by a parent/guardian, the student, a teacher, and/or as a result of a review of achievement data. Requests for gifted screening are made in writing to the school counselor.

**What happens after a student is screened?** Parents/guardians will be notified of the results of the screening.
