Summer Camp Information Sheet

Contact Information: A valid telephone number must be on file at the camp in case of an emergency. Please be sure to provide updated information as soon as possible.

Court Documents: If you have court documents restricting access to your child, you must provide the camp with copies of these legal documents.

Discipline Policy: Discipline policies shall be tailored to meet the needs of the specific programs. Positive reinforcement principles will be used in dealing with children. If problems persist which affect the safety and educational enrichment of the other children in the program, the camp program reserves the right to suspend or expel a child from the program.

Citizenship warnings for disciplinary reasons will be given to the children as follows:

- First and Second Warning: Must be signed by parent/guardian and returned.
- Third Warning: Must be signed and returned. The child will have one week of suspension from the program.
- Fourth Warning: The child will not be allowed to return to the camp program. All refunds are at the discretion of the camp director with approval from the school's principal.

Nutritional Snacks Requirement: Students will prepare their own snacks daily at camp. However, if your child does not want the pre-selected menu items, parents must furnish their child with a nutritious

snack. Students are not allowed to bring canned or bottled soda, candy or microwave popcorn to the camp for snacks.

Lunch Requirement: Students may bring their own lunches. However, lunch may be provided through the school cafeteria. Students are not allowed to bring canned or bottled soda, candy or microwave popcorn to the camp for lunch.

Illness: Children who are ill should not come to camp, for their good as well as for the good of others. If a child becomes ill or is injured while at camp, parents will be notified to pick up their child immediately. **Children cannot return to camp until they are without fever (without the aid of medicine) for 24 hours.**

Admission / Dismissal Procedures: For accountability purposes, and to ensure the safety of all children enrolled in the camp, the following procedures must be followed:

- **PARENTS/GUARDIANS MUST TEXT 904-424-1879 UPON ARRIVAL AT PARKING LOT.**
- **ALL CAMP CHILDREN MUST BE HEALTH SCREENED AT THE BACK GATE FROM THE BACK PARKING LOT.**
- **ALL CAMP CHILDREN MUST BE SIGNED IN ON ADMISSION LOG IN.**
- **THOSE INDIVIDUALS SIGNING CHILDREN OUT MUST BE PREPARED TO PRESENT PROPER PICTURE IDENTIFICATION.**
- **STUDENT WILL BE ESCORTED OUT TO BACK GATE.**
- **ONLY THOSE PERSONS AUTHORIZED IN WRITING ON THE CAMP REGISTRATION FORM WILL BE ALLOWED TO REMOVE THE CHILDREN FROM THE PROGRAM.**

Camp Attire: We spend a lot of time outside. Be aware that your child will be exposed to sunlight, dirt, sand and other natural elements, as well as to art, craft and cooking supplies. Please send items of clothing with your child that will withstand possible messes and potential stains. **Please send an extra set of clothes and underclothes in case of spills.**

Sunscreen: Please apply sunscreen to your child before camp each day. Your child may bring a labeled bottle of sunscreen and/or a labeled sunscreen stick to camp for self-reapplication. You can also fill out an over-the-counter medication form giving camp staff permission to apply sunscreen to your child. We will remind children to reapply sunscreen at numerous points throughout the day. Sunscreen is particularly important on water day!
