





# Fall 2017 Instructional Culture Index scores range from 4.4 to 10 across Duval schools, with an average score of 7.9.


Index Scores by School




# Index scores also vary widely within most school groups, and all groups have at least one school in the Duval top quartile.




## Three-quarters of Duval schools had Index scores within one point of their Fall 2016 score.






## Teachers plan to leave top-quartile schools at half the rate of bottom-quartile schools.

Teachers planning to leave this year or next year




# Teachers planning to leave bottom-quartile schools more often cite dissatisfaction with school culture, school leadership, and student conduct.

#### Reasons Teachers Plan to Leave Their Schools




# Conversely, the most common reason teachers plan to stay at top-quartile schools is positive school culture.
