Program Overview

The Duval County Public School's Educator Entrance Program, Ready, Set, Teach (RST), is designed for professionals who earned a Bachelor's Degree from a non-college of education program, but have the skills to and interest in beginning a career in education as an elementary school teacher.

Summer Session Schedule

- Participants complete a test preparation program
 - May 15, 2017 – June 29, 2017
- By May 22nd – Participants register to take exam in July
- July 30th – Apply for Elementary Education Temporary Teaching Certificate
- August 2017 – Eligible for Employment & Offered Contract*
- Fall 2018 – Enroll into Alternative Certification Program

***Upon program completion and a passing score on exam, participants will be offered employment with DCPS. New teachers will transition into the Alternative Certification Program, working towards a professional teaching certificate.**

Year 1: Study Materials - \$50

Year 2: ACP Program - \$950
Paid in 3 Installments
