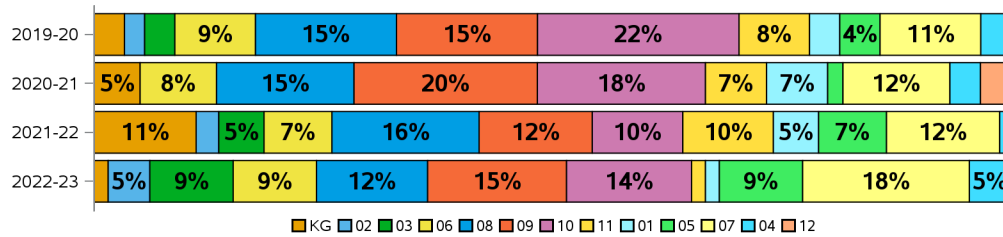

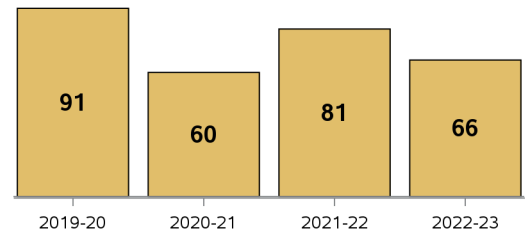

Enrollment by Grade



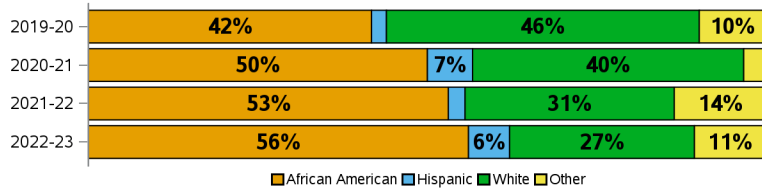

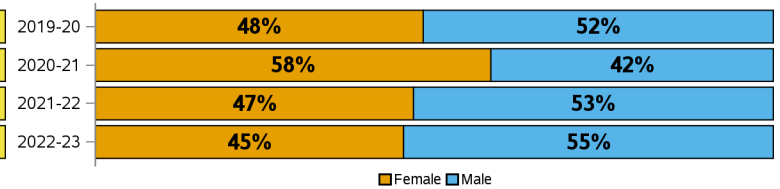

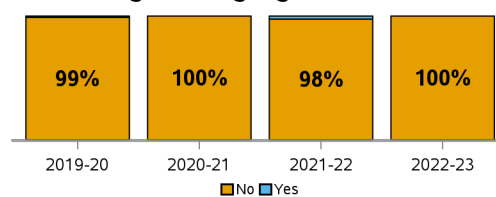
Race/Ethnicity Breakdown



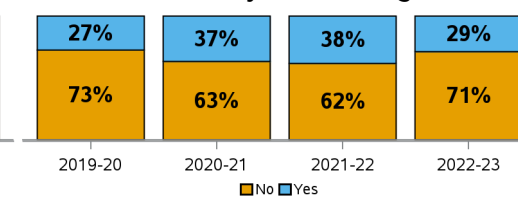
Gender Breakdown



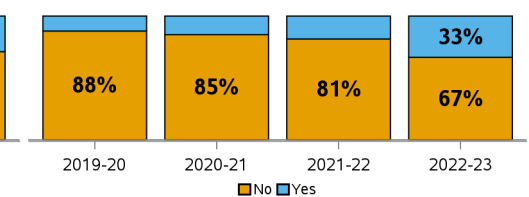

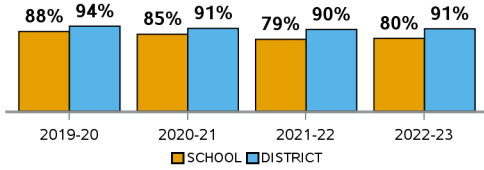

Suspension Event % is determined by the number of total Referrals that had an Internal/Out of School event as part of the Referral.

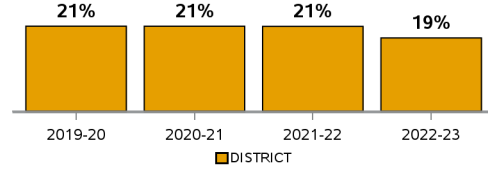

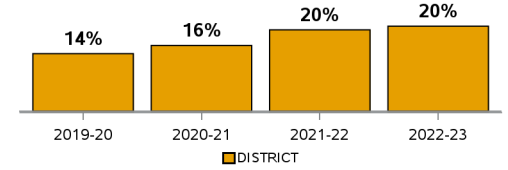

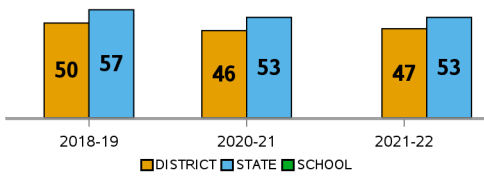

Gain - Percentage of full-year enrolled students who achieved a learning gain from the prior year to the current year.

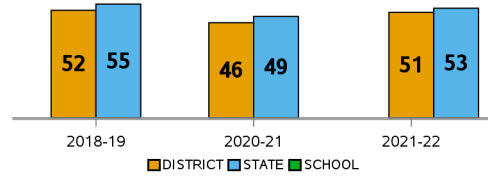

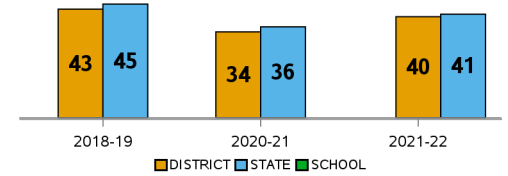

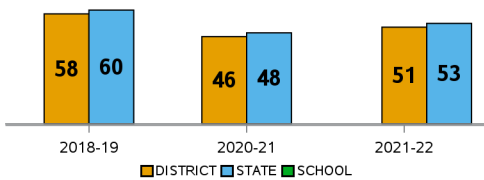
ELA Gains (Bottom Quartile)

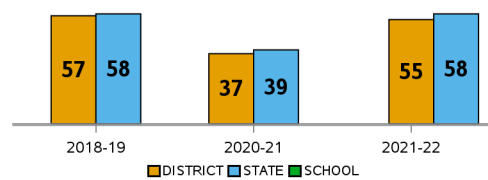

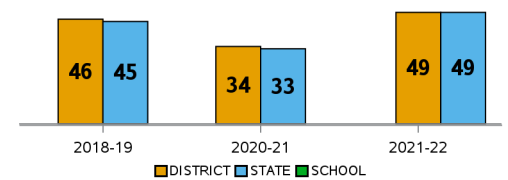

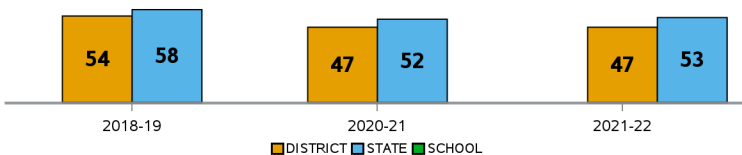
Math Gains (Bottom Quartile)

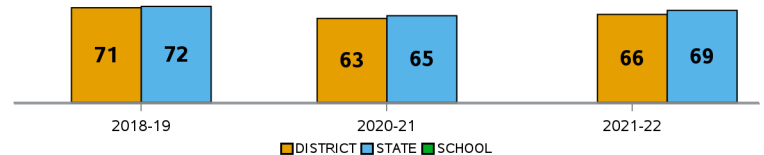

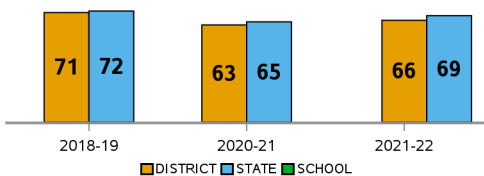

This is the percentage of 8th grade students who are proficient in a High School Honors Course, or earned an Industry Certification the prior year.

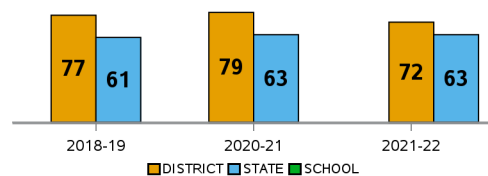
